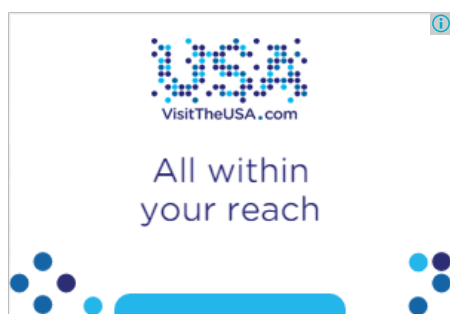

### Taiwan delegation looks for cooperation chances in India

NEW DELHI--A Taiwanese delegation visited several scientific research and development institutions in India Thursday to explore opportunities for cooperation after attending the Indo Taiwan Joint Workshop on Digital Technologies for Societal Use which concluded the day before in Delhi.



The delegation, composed of 10 science and technology officials, experts and industry representatives, was led by Shieh Ce-kuen, director of Taiwan's National Applied Research Laboratory's (NARL) National Center for High-performance Computing (NCHC).

During the two day workshop, Taiwanese delegates engaged in discussions with 22 officials

the state-owned Media Labor Asia.

After the conclusion of the workshop, the delegation on Thursday visited the Center for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC) and the Center for Development of Telematics in India to tap into cooperation opportunities.

The workshop opened Tuesday during a ceremony presided over by Arabinda Mitra, the head of the International Bilateral Cooperation Division under India's DST, with the attendance of Henry H. H. Chen, director of the Science and Technology Division under the Taipei Economic and Cultural Center in New Delhi.

Representatives from the two countries talked about cooperation on the use of digital technologies to promote agricultural and rural development, health passports and equipment for disabled people, and environmental protection.

Chadaram Sivaji, an expert from India's DST, said the two countries also wanted to cooperate and complement each other in the development of the information, communications and electronics and bamboo handicrafts industries.
